

Central Scotland Highland Pony Clubs Biggest show Yet!

Central Scotland Highland Pony Club held their Annual Show at Strathallan Castle on Sunday 4th September 2011 and what a show it was! It was their 21st Anniversary Show and was set to be their largest ever with 105 ponies catalogued and more entering on the day! Entries came from all over Scotland and the North of England and the sun shone to welcome them all!

The day started bright and early with the inhand section judged by Willie Nelson. Well filled classes meant that he was kept busy for the whole morning. His eventual champion was the Bairds Brood Mare, Gaynor of Whitefield, with the reserve going to Willie Allan's Yeld Mare, Meika of Millfield.

Erik McKechnie had the mammoth task of judging the large entry of ridden ponies split over 4 classes, Nursery Novice, Novice, <14hh Open & >14hh Open. There were 15 ponies forward for the Novice ridden class alone, the largest I have seen all year, and there was even a well known professional 3 day eventer spotted on board one of the ponies!! Erik chose his Nursery Novice winner as his novice champion, Fearliath Mor of Abernethy ridden by Jo Jack. Reserve Novice Ridden went to Alison McLeods young stallion Glenmore of Roisbheinn. The open ridden section saw a good number of quality ponies forward for Erik to cast an eye over and it was Alison Cooks' 8 year old gelding, Blackjack of Logierait II that took the Open Championship. Reserve went to Glenbanchor Somerled, owned and ridden by Eleanor Steven.

East of Scotland Farmers Grand In-hand Final is class held every year at the CSHPC Show and is open to all Champion & Reserve Highland Ponies from HPS affiliated Shows in Scotland. This year, it was judged by Mr John Reid and he had 12 ponies forward for judging. His champion was the stunning Moss-side Quercus Rubra owned by W & J Ralston. This 4 year old stallion, by Moss-side Iain Mhor was also champion at Perth Show in August. The reserve went to Thorn Holly, owned by Morven Campbell. The best youngstock was Charlie McQuattie's Rosie of Strathmore.

The Working Hunter Pony section was judged by Catriona McArdle. There were a good number of ponies forward to tackle the 3 height classes, many of whom were "giving it a go" for the first time. Champion for the section went to Blackjack of Logierait II owned by Alison Cook and reserve was Judith Pages', Trowan Monty.

Lady Mary Hope very kindly judged the dressage section for the day, with 2 tests to choose from it meant that riders and ponies of all abilities could have the chance to compete.

Last section of the day was the Junior Section, judged by Mr John Reid. There was Tack & Turnout, Inhand and Ridden sections for our Juniors to compete in, culminating in an Overall Junior Performance Trophy. This year, the trophy was won by 11 year old Rebecca Prempeh from Kippen, riding Stuartdene.

Finally, all of the champions from the inhand, ridden and workers came together to be judged for the Show Champion. The judges decision saw the Bairds brood mare take the show champion and the HPS Bronze Medal and Alison Cook's, Blackjack of Logierait II was reserve.
